ELECTION RESULTS

Elections were held in the City of Page on June 12th for the position of Mayor and two city council seats.

Shane Larck ran unopposed for Mayor and was re-elected with 96.36% of the vote with a write-in candidate receiving two votes.

Tom Atkinson was re-elected to the City Council with 40.34% of the vote. Jim Heidorn won the second seat on the council with 21.85% of the vote. The remaining three candidates were Justin Dahl, receiving 20.17% of the vote; Tanya Ferguson with 12.61% and Keith Haas with 3.36%. A write-in candidate received two votes.

The organizational meeting for the Page City Council will be held on Tuesday, June 26th at 6:00 pm and the next regular Council meeting will be held at the Page City Auditorium on Monday, July 9th at 6:00 pm.

CITY LANDFILL

The burning of the Page City Landfill is regulated by the State and is therefore inspected regularly. The Landfill is to be used only for the disposal of trees and branches and other clean burning waste such as lumber and wooden furniture. The Landfill will be open on the 3rd Thursday of each month from 5:30 pm to 7:00 pm. If you have any questions on what can or cannot be disposed of in the Landfill or to request an appointment time for disposal other than the times listed above, please call 668-2226.

Cass County residents have the option of receiving severe weather warning alerts by phone through the CodeRED Weather Warning alert system. The system calls residents to warn them if the National Weather Service has issued a severe thunderstorm warning, a tornado warning or a flash flood warning. Weather alerts are an optional service and residents are able to choose which weather alerts they would like to receive.
