MAY 12th – 18th

Look for large roll-off dumpsters behind the Page City Auditorium. This is for mattresses, old furniture, toys, clothes, etc. **Unacceptable Materials: No free liquids of any kind or hazardous material (paint, etc.), asbestos, auto parts, tires, batteries, fluorescent bulbs, major appliances (including microwaves), electronics (tv's, computers) or yard waste.** Leaves and grass should be taken to compost pile. Trees and branches can be taken to the City Dumpground. If you have any appliances, set them on the curb for pickup. There will be a \$20.00 charge for the pickup of refrigerators, freezers or air conditioners due to the Freon. To schedule appliance pickup or if you have any questions, call 668-2226.

All sump pumps must be draining outside and not into the sanitary sewer system. A fine of **\$250.00** will be issued if this is not done.
